Clean Interceptor Pit:

There must be No Smoking or Mobile Phones on site.

- ✓ Adhere to site speed restriction & park in contractor designated area(s)
- ✓ Report to site, sign in.
- ✓ Adhere to site Health & Safety rules at all time
- ✓ Ensure the site representative is familiar with the operation.
- ✓ Obtain permit to work.
- ✓ First aid facility on site would be utilised in the event of a accident/ incident.
- ✓ In the event of an emergency follow site evacuation procedure.
- ✓ Change into PPE
- ✓ Ensure non-work related personnel are excluded from the area.
- ✓ Only utilised equipment brought on site as listed above under "Equipment"
- ✓ Remove the liquid phase
- ✓ Remove Inspection plate
- ✓ The vacuum tanker will be positioned safely with regards to traffic
- ✓ Suction hoses to be laid out safely from the tanker to the vertical tanks.
- ✓ The operator will engage the pumping equipment on board the tanker in order to build up the vacuum.
- ✓ The valves will be opened on the tanker; this will draw in any residual liquid content from the tank, into the tanker. With the assistance of a jetting hose to slurry up the solid waste residues.
- ✓ Operator to visually inspect the hoses for any leakages throughout the pumping operation.
- ✓ IBC must be checked visually for integrity, any defective containers should be either corrected or rejected
- ✓ Erase all labelling on IBC with paint & replace with identifying conveyance labels
- ✓ The tanker will relocate on site and decant its load into IBC's on site.
- ✓ Remove all equipment
- ✓ Prior to leaving ensure area is clean & tidy
- ✓ Change out of PPE
- ✓ Sign off site proceed to notify all relevant personnel

Please Note:

- Remove all previous labels, allowing for clarity of identification in the event of an accident
- Labels must be clearly legible when the container is in transport position & stand out from the background & be readily noticeable
- Be clearly indelibly printed on a securely fastened label
